What is Information Security?

Today, the two most important assets of any organization are the people who make it work, and the information they use to do so. This information is embodied in the vital records, policies and procedures that predicate virtually every aspect of operating a business. In addition to internal data, outside agencies such as governments, financial institutions, insurance companies and even courts require that specific records be maintained. 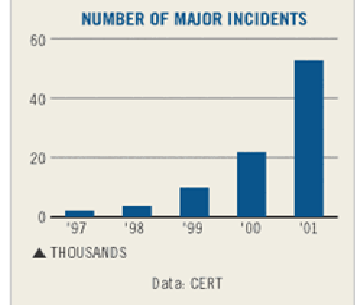
